**Traditional Costumes Required**

Trailers will be limited to 40, 16 Association Trailers, on a first come first serve basis a \$30.00 fee per trailer will be charged. Tag will be issued. All riders on trailers or truck bed must register & pay \$30 fee. All riders on trailers or truck bed must be dressed in traditional Mardi Gras costumes.

**DRIVER CANNOT CONSUME ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES  
BEFORE OR DURING THE RUN - MUST BE 18 YRS. OF AGE.**

A registration tag must be displayed on vehicle.

Pre-Registration for trailers will be on Saturday, Feb. 11th  
from 9:00 A.M.-2:00 P.M. at the City Hall.

Runners will register the morning of run at Northwest.  
Current proof of insurance is required on Tow Vehicle!

Trailers must not exceed 20 ft. - No Doubles!

No Portalets or runners allowed behind truck.

Must have 3 ft. wall around the front & sides of trailers.
